## Minutes of Epsilon Psi Executive Board Meeting April 16, 2020

President JoAnn Short initiated a conference call meeting of the Epsilon Psi Executive Board at 3:00pm, April 16, 2020. Present were: JoAnn Short, Judi Mitchell, Kathryn Wright, Julie Kellner, Carolyn Florus, and Carolyn Francis. Joyce Cloudt and Laura Kellner were not present.

## Items that were discussed:

- April 23 meeting was cancelled. We were supposed to install officers and vote on Nominations Committee members at that meeting.
- May 14 meeting was cancelled.

These cancellation decisions were made by the Executive Board per Governor Abbott's Covid 19 mandates and not knowing when they will be lifted. Not knowing what the future holds as far as meetings, we wanted to have a plan in place for when we can begin to meet together again.

No decision to cancel was made about the August breakfast meeting. If the August meeting takes place, we would like to meet with Gamma Nu as we did last August.
