The dual format in person and Zoom meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by President Kristen Davis with a quorum established and the secretary being present. Roll was taken by Carolyn Francis with twelve members and one guest being present.

Carolyn Florus led us in the Chapter Collect, and members joined in the Response.

Old Business

The October minutes were approved as printed in the November newsletter.

The October financial report prepared by Treasurer Carolyn Francis was printed in the November newsletter and will be filed for audit.

Program

- Kristen Davis introduced the necrology service for four of our members who have recently passed. Julie Kellner, chair of the Necrology Committee, led the memorial ceremonies for Aida Dyer, Ouida Carroll, Shirley Wright, and Jean Lee that honored the friendship, loyalty, and service of each one.
- A video interview of Charter Member Ouida Carroll was shown, then Therese Ruff paid tribute to Ouida, a lifelong Baytonian whose father was one of the first to be employed by Humble Oil. She enjoyed a 43 -year career in education and was a member of Epsilon Psi for fifty-nine years. She served our chapter as president and secretary. Ouida was dear friends with Therese's mother Boudy Norton. She dearly loved her nieces, nephews and all her family. Here are her own words, "Learning was so much fun, that's what I wanted to be. Teaching needs to be your first choice. Teaching is a ministry." Ouida passed on May 23, 2019.
- Julie Kellner and Pearl Campbell from Sacred Heart Catholic Church paid tribute to Aida Dyer, an immigrant from Costa Rica, who had a beautiful life in the service of her new country. She was fluent in three languages. Aida had the distinction, when she was hired in 1975, of being GCCISD's only ESL secondary teacher. She retired after 35 years in the classroom. She was active in our chapter and involved in her church. In 1987, she and her husband and friends dedicated a new Crosby Branch to the Harris County Public Library System. She was instrumental in impacting women educators worldwide by facilitating the establishment of Delta Kappa Gamma chapters in her homeland of Costa Rica. Aida passed on May 25, 2021.
- Carolyn Francis spoke about our dear friend Jean Lee who was born October 1, 1931. She graduated valedictorian of her high school then met her future husband OB on the campus of Sam Houston State. She didn't talk loyalty; she lived it. She spent most of her 36-year tenure with GCCISD as librarian at Carver Jones High School, Baytown Junior High, and Robert E. Lee High School. After retirement, she spent 17 years as the research librarian at Sterling Municipal Library. Jean was initiated into Delta Kappa Gamma on October 26, 1972, and served our chapter faithfully as treasurer, first vice-president, president, and chair of many committees. She served on the state level as area coordinator, first vice-president, committee chairs and received the prestigious State Achievement Award. She was awarded the Member-in-Print Award many times. She was instrumental in establishing One Heart-Two Languages, also known as the Mexico Project. We are proud of the many accomplishments she had on the chapter, state, and international levels. She loved learning and giving, so she was a wonderful mentor to Carolyn Francis and many others. Jean passed October 20, 2021.
- Laura Kellner brought memories of her dear friend, Shirley Wright. Shirley was valedictorian of her high school and went to Rice where she was destined to meet her future husband Bobby. Shirley and Laura also met and became instant friends when they spent time together cheering on their favorite football players. Shirley was an English teacher and became the English Department chair at Sterling High School. Shirley was initiated into Delta Kappa Gamma on October 26, 2006, and she served on many committees. She loved to decorate for her famous festive Christmas open house, and just about all occasions including showers and weddings. She was the "social director" at school. Shirley was a true friend to many and very giving of her time and talents. The Wrights and the Kellners developed a close friendship that included many happy trips in their motor homes. Shirley passed on April 19, 2020.
