#### **New Business:**

Kristen Davis reported on the Area 3 Workshop held on Zoom format the morning of September 12, 2020. Epsilon Psi members attending were Kristen Davis, Carolyn Francis and Mattie Sharp.

Membership Chairman JoAnn Short moved to accept with regrets the resignations of Judy Abshier, Lindsey Barnett, and Lacy White. The motion passed.

Finance Committee Chairman Carolyn Florus along with Treasurer Carolyn Francis and President Kristen Davis presented the new budget for 2020-2021 for approval. Following explanations, Carolyn Florus moved we accept the budget as presented. The motion passed.

#### Program:

Karen Coffey, reading specialist and dyslexia expert, presented the program, "Teaching Reading Is Not Rocket Science". For students learning to read, three areas on the left side of their brain must work efficiently: the temporal lobe, the occipital lobe, and the frontal lobe. The main causes for difficulty in learning to read are learning disabilities such as dyslexia, lack of exposure to print, and language barriers. Struggling students who miss instruction due to Covid-19 will likely need targeted intervention in addition to that already offered by our local districts. Karen introduced us to a new reading initiative called Learner Dynamics. It is an afterschool tutoring program designed to remove financial barriers, to offer one-on-one interventions created by diagnosticians and taught by certified teachers, with mentoring for parents. Karen emailed her outline of the program and a flyer for Learner Dynamics with information on the initiative and how to donate. Donna Mohlman added there are 917 eBooks available to everyone at no cost through the Lee College Mobile Go Center. These Interactive Library resources are provided by DKG grants and matched by Capstone. Donna emailed the instructions to access this free library.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:25 p.m. with the singing of "The Delta Kappa Gamma Song".
