## A NOTE FROM Julie...


Dear Delta Kappa Gamma Sisters,

#### Minutes of the Epsilon Psi Chapter of The Delta

### Kappa Gamma Society International

August 13, 2016

Twenty members of the Epsilon Psi Chapter of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International gathered for fellowship and breakfast at 8:00am, Saturday, August 13, 2016, at Golden Corral. The secretary and a quorum being present, President Julie Kellner called the meeting to order at 8:30am. Laura Kellner asked the blessing.

Donna Mohlman gave a report on the DKG International Convention which she attended this summer in Nashville, Tennessee. She also reported that the Lee College Mobile Go Center is up and going and will be at JD Walker Community Center in McNair on August 21 from 3:30-6:00pm. Volunteers are needed. Send Donna your email address (if she doesn't already have it), and you will get an email that will allow you to sign up as a volunteer. Dr. Ruby Payne will be speaking on September 14, 2016, at the Baytown Spring Hill Suites on I-10. The time is 7:30-9:00am. The price is \$35.00 per person or a table for 10 can be purchased for \$300.00.

Richie Butler led the Collect and Response. Julie said how glad she is to be our president for the next two years.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as published in the August DKG Newsletter. The treasurer's report was also in the newsletter and will be filed for audit. Treasurer Carolyn Francis reminded us that 2016-2017 dues were due. Dues forms and the budget report were on the tables.

President Kellner reported that the executive board met on July 19, 2016, and selected chairmen for the 2016-2018 biennium. Nominations Committee will consist of Sarah Guarnere – secondary, Julie Kellner – elementary, and Judi Mitchell – retired.

Carolyn Florus and the Finance Committee met on August 11 to audit the books. The Finance Committee moved that the budget be approved. The motion carried. The Finance Committee also moved that we transfer our Scholarship Fund and our General Savings Account from Community Resource into a money market account at Amegy Bank. Treasurer Carolyn Francis explained that this would make it easier to access our money when we need it. The motion carried.

Membership Chairman Pat Cauley put membership recommendation cards on the tables. The new membership form can be found on our website. These cards or, preferably, the new membership form should be turned in to Pat before September 12. She reviewed our Epsilon Psi membership in the past. In 1990 we had 59 members, 13 of which are still active. We presently have 47 members: 43 active, 3 reserve, and 1 honorary. She stated that in thinking of prospective members, keep in mind the high standards we have always had. Carolyn Francis reminded us that we are now able to ask a prospective member if they would be interested in being a member of Epsilon Psi. Julie reminded us that we can also reinstate former DKG members. The membership committee will meet September 12 at Pat's house at 4:30.

Paula Jackson reported that our next meeting will be at First Baptist Church, 505 Rollingbrook, on September 22, 2016. Fellowship will be at 4:30pm with meeting beginning at 5:00pm. The program will be an update of the new teacher appraisal system.

Julie thanked everyone for bringing school supplies. These will go to Meagan Lowery who will distribute them.

Julie meet with the Gamma Nu Storybook Christmas Committee to select this year's book to be distributed to all  $1^{\rm st}$  graders in Baytown and Barber's Hill.

Carolyn Francis reminded members who were not wearing their DKG key pins to contribute 25 cents to the piggy bank. The money collected will benefit ASTEF.
